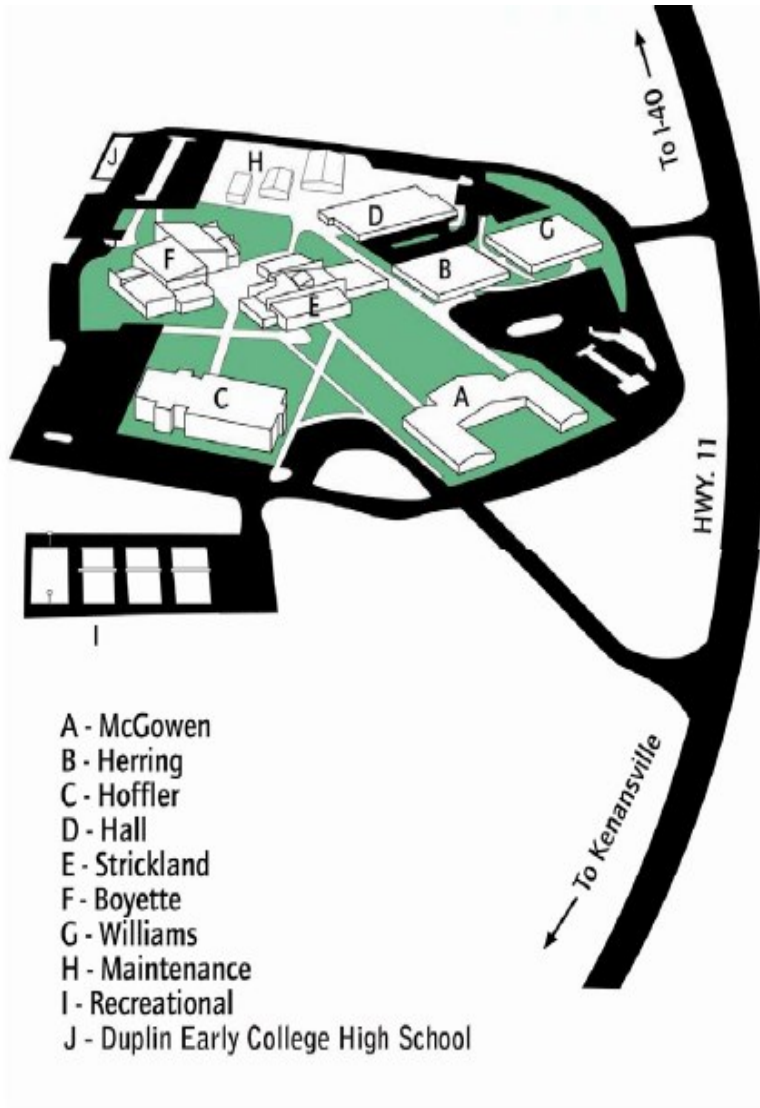

## Courses

**\*Friday Attendance is Mandatory for Classes that Begin on Friday Night\***

### 1. Basic Firefighting

This non-certification course is designed for the new firefighter with little or no experience. Practical applications will be used extensively. **Full turnout gear and SCBA with an extra cylinder required. Junior firefighters must have their chief's authorization and signature on the registration form.** (Fri. 7-10 PM, Sat. 8 AM-5 PM, Sun. 8 AM-1 PM).

### 2. Orientation and Safety

This certification-related course enables the firefighter to become aware of the advanced operations of the department and understand their position in the organization from a more detailed perspective. Course topics will also include a review of advanced safety regulations and the firefighter's responsibility to comply with those regulations; the elements of an advanced departmental safety program; and the advanced hazards related to fire protection. This course is part of the NC Firefighter Certification Program approved by the NC Fire and Rescue Commission. The student must pass the end of course exam(s) to receive certification credit. **Full Turnout Gear and SCBA is required. Class begins Friday Night. Friday night attendance is mandatory.** (Fri. 6-10 PM, Sat. 8 AM-5 PM, Sun. 8 AM-1 PM).

### 3. Water Supplies

This certification course is designed to teach the firefighter candidate the methods of moving water from a source to an emergency scene, as well as to teach the basic components of a local water distribution system. This course is part of the NC Firefighter Certification Program approved by the NC Fire and Rescue Commission. The student must pass the end of course exam(s) to receive certification credit. **Full Turnout Gear is required. Class begins Friday Night. Friday night attendance is mandatory.** (Fri. 6-10 PM, Sat. 8 AM-6 PM, Sun. 8 AM-1 PM)

### 4. D/O Introduction to Pumps

This certification-related course will explain and identify job or individual requirements for pump operators and will detail safe operation of the vehicle. It will also detail the safe operation as well as the basic aspects of positive displacement and centrifugal pumps. This Pumps Introduction course is part of the Pumps Certification Program approved by the NC Fire and Rescue Commission. The student must pass the end of course exam(s) to receive certification credit. **Class begins Friday Night. Friday night attendance is mandatory.** (Fri. 7-10 PM, Sat. 8 AM-5 PM, Sun. 8 AM-12 PM).

### 5. D/O Basic Aerial Operations

This certification-related course will review the application and use of various types of aerials including articulating booms, telescoping booms, elevated platforms, and aerial ladders. It will detail tip loads and uses of master streams from aerial devices. This is a NC Fire and Rescue Commission certification course. This Aerial Basic Operations course is part of the Aerials Certification Program approved by the NC Fire and Rescue Commission. The student must pass the end of course exam(s) to receive certification credit. **Class begins Friday Night. Friday night attendance is mandatory.** (Fri. 7-10 PM, Sat. 8 AM-5 PM, Sun. 8 AM-12 PM).

### 6. Right Seat Ready

Whether you are a new leader or one looking to improve this course is for you. The fire service often puts firefighters and officers in the position to make fire ground decisions with little training to be an officer. The goal of this course is to prepare the present and future leaders of the fire service for the responsibilities they face. This non-certification course will cover topics from the time the call is received to placing apparatus and equipment back in service and includes the use of a tabletop exercise to reinforce topics covered. (Fri. 7-10 PM, Sat. 8 AM-5 PM, Sun. 8 AM-1 PM).

### 7. Live Fire Training

This class will provide hands-on live fire training utilizing a Conex Burn Prop. Training will focus on performing actual fire ground skills under intense and realistic conditions. Students will rotate through live fire evolutions. Training is designed to develop, build, and enhance decision making for structural fire operations. **Full turnout gear and SCBA with an extra cylinder required. Must be 18 years of age or older and have the chief's authorization and signature verifying 1403 required training to participate.** (Fri. 7-10 PM, Sat. 8 AM-5 PM). \*Class limited to 25 students.

### 8. Grain Bin Rescue

This class will provide Fire/Rescue personnel with a basic awareness of strategies for preventing and responding to grain-related entrapments, including partial and full engulfment. This course will cover the primary causes of grain-related entrapments, grain storage design and operation, rescue strategies, and responder injury prevention. Demonstrations and hands on experiences will be provided. **Class begins Friday Night. Friday night attendance is mandatory.** (Fri. 7-10 PM, Sat. 8 AM-5 PM). \*Class limited to 25 students.
